He is a unique and dedicated artist, known and loved for his passionate, gifted way of communicating with the public. He plays the Modelo Corvado 42 string harp, the cuatro, a Colombian-Venezuelan folk instrument, and also, as an accompaniment, the Spanish guitar.

He has given several benefit performances. His last concert, Grano de Arena, in aid of Children of the Andes, in September last year at St James's Church, Piccadilly, raised significant funds.

Ricardo is an innovative performer with professional experience and he is a soloist prepared to perform on any stage and playing contemporary and traditional harp music from different Latin American countries. He specializes with classical, flamenco and jazz music and poetry.
